

Land Use Permit: Agricultural Buildings Acknowledgement

I understand that the State Building Code requires compliance/inspection with the building code for non-agricultural buildings. I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the State definition for agricultural building and attest that my parcel is classified as agricultural by the Kandiyohi County Assessor and that my proposed building meets the following definition.

In accordance with Sec. 16B60 of the Minnesota State Building Code agricultural buildings are defined as “a structure on agricultural land as defined by section 273.13, subdivision 23, designed, constructed, and used to house farm implements, livestock, or agricultural produce or products used by the owner, lessee, and sublessee of the building and members of their immediate families, their employees, and persons engaged in the pickup or delivery of agricultural produce or products”.
