

**Child Protection Services♥** - are provided to families in which a maltreatment assessment found a level of risk to indicate the need for protective services.

Our staff determines what services are needed to help support a family in need so they can safely care for their child. Services for families may include family counseling, parenting education, assistance in applying for financial benefits, helping a family access services such as early childhood or special education children, and/or helping the family meet basic need such as housing and food.

Each family is unique, so child protection workers assess what services, if any, the family needs, and makes every effort to provide the identified services that will best help that individual family, and in turn assure child safety.
