Please sort your materials into these categories and set out on curb by 8:00 am on day of pickup.

Metal

- YES-** Metal food and beverage bottles and jars rinsed out, labels are OK
- NO-** Paint/aerosol cans



Glass



- YES-** Glass food and beverage bottles and jars rinsed out, labels are OK
- NO-** Drinking glasses, mugs, dishes, cookware, pottery, vases, window/mirror



Plastic

- YES-** Containers and bottles marked with one of the plastic recycling symbols **shown above**—rinsed out, discard caps/lids*, labels are OK *Replace caps on well-drained motor oil bottles
- NO-** Containers and bottles over 5 gallons
- NO-** Plastic wrap, shopping/salt bags, etc.

Newspaper

- YES-** Newspaper inserts, advertisements & paper bags
- NO-** Plastic newspaper bags, rubberbands, etc.



Paper/Magazines/Paperboard

- YES-** Mail, office/school papers, magazines, catalogs, phone books
- YES-** Boxes: cereal, cracker, pasta, cake mix, pop/soda, egg cartons, toothpaste, medications and other toiletries—flattened boxes/no liners
- NO-** Pizza boxes or boxes soiled with food, boxes from refrigerated or frozen foods, paper towels/napkins/plates/gift wrap, plastic binders/clips



- YES-** Shredded paper in closed paper bag

Corrugated Cardboard

- YES-** ONLY accepted at Willmar Recycling Center—flatten boxes and place in cages at Recycling Center
- NO-** Not accepted curbside or recycling sheds
