

Household Hazardous Waste

The Kandiyohi County Regional Household Hazardous Waste facility is located next to the Recycling Center and accepts a **variety** of household chemicals for **safe** disposal.

Florescent and HID Bulbs

Willmar Municipal Utilities and Kandiyohi Power Coop residential customers bring a copy of your billing statement for **free** disposal.

For business accounts and other utilities:

Florescent Bulbs .50 each.
HID Bulbs \$1.00 each.



Batteries

We accept: rechargeable batteries, small sealed lead acid (often labeled "PB-acid or "lead acid"), Nickel Cadmium (often labeled "Ni-Cad"), Lithium (often labeled "Li or CR or BR").

Recycle **auto batteries** at the County Landfill or any business that sells auto batteries.

Dispose of **Alkaline** batteries in the regular trash.



Oil and Oil Filters

Recycle oil and oil filters at the Kandiyohi County Landfill's **oil recycling area** or any place in the State of MN that provides oil change services. Disposal is free of charge at any location.

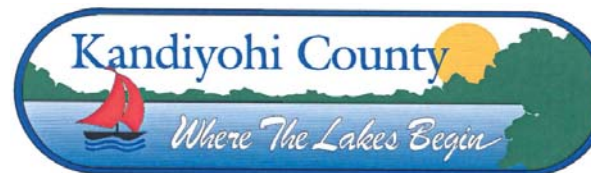

Recycling at your curb, recycling shed or recycling center (sorted by group)

GLASS

YES:

- Glass food, beverage bottles and jars

NO:

- Drinking glasses, mugs, dishes, cookware, pottery, vases, window/mirror glass, etc.



METAL

YES:

- Metal food, beverage bottles and jars

NO:

- Paint cans
- Aerosol cans



PAPER/MAGAZINES/ PAPERBOARD/CARTONS



YES:

- Mail, office and school papers
- Magazines and catalogs
- Shredded paper in closed paper bag
- Egg cartons
- Boxes: cereal, cracker, pasta, cake mix, pop/soda, toothpaste, medications and other toiletries
- Shelf-stable cartons: juice boxes, milk, soy milk, soup/broth, wine (remove straws, caps OK)
- Refrigerated cartons: milk, juice, cream, egg substitutes (remove straws, caps OK)



NO:

- Pizza boxes or boxes soiled with food
- Boxes from refrigerated or frozen foods
- Paper towels / napkins / plates / gift wrap

NEWSPAPER

YES:

- Newspapers, inserts and advertisements
- Paper bags



NO:

- Plastic newspaper bags, rubberbands, etc.*

*Plastic shopping bags are recyclable at many grocery/retail stores.

YES:

- Containers and bottles marked on the bottom with one of the plastic recycling symbols (see above)
- Replace caps on well-drained motor oil bottles

NO:

- Containers and bottles over 5 gallons
- Plastic wrap, shopping / salt bags, etc.*

*Plastic shopping bags are recyclable at many grocery/retail stores.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

YES:

- **ONLY** accepted at Willmar Recycling Center
- Flatten boxes and place in cages at Recycling Center

NO:

- Not accepted curbside or recycling shed
